

ARIA 2022 Annual Meeting Oral Research Presenter Information

We look forward to seeing you in Long Beach. Following is information to help orient you to the specifics of the oral presentation set up.

Session Format

Each concurrent session is 90 minutes long, has three presenters (occasionally two presenters) and allows 30 minutes to each presentation. There are six breakout rooms going on during the same 90 minutes. Sessions are numbered with a letter/number combination for each presentation to help organize the agenda in the digital Event App (please see more information on the Event App below).

- The notation A1 denotes the content of the session. This is where Moderators are named.
- The added notation such as A1a, A1b, and A1c denote the three presentations in that room and the order they will present. Please do not change the order of the presentations. If A1a is no longer listed, A1b will be the first presentation in that session. All sessions should follow the following time format:
- Timing
 - a. Presentations:
 - i. For three presentations it is 20 minute maximum (18-20 minutes)
 - ii. For only two presentations, you may allow a bit more time, but presenters have been given the information of the timing listed below.
 - b. Discussants: 5 minute maximum
 - c. Audience Q&A: 5 minutes

Preparing for the Session

Each meeting room will include a podium, a side high-top for presenter materials, a screen, projector, and computer. Presenters will be advised to bring their presentations on a thumb drive and load it onto the computer's laptop just prior to the start of the session. No presentations should be shown from a cloud file due to the unpredictable nature of the internet. There are no microphones in the concurrent sessions. All involved in the sessions, you, presenters, and discussants are encouraged to arrive in the meeting room 10-15 minutes before the start of the session to load presentations and orient themselves.

What is the Event App (the only agenda) and Where are the Papers?

The Annual Meeting Agenda is contained in a digital Event App and thus is the most up-to-date agenda that can be provided as it allows real-time updates, and push announcements to all in attendance. It works on computer, phone, and tablet. You should download the Event App to your mobile phone before coming to the conference. Wifi will be available to all in their hotel rooms and the meeting space, allowing access to the App to all. **The session papers are linked to each session in the Event App. Access to the App for all registrants was released on July 6, 2022.** Registrants after that date were entered and provides access on a day-by-day basis.
